

The award criterion is the significance of the paper with respect to original contributions to research advances or professional practice in environmental geotechnologists. The first Hsai-Yang Fang Research Award will be presented at the 7th International Symposium of Environmental Geotechnologists and Global Sustainable Development (ISEGGSD) to be held in Helsinki, Finland in 2004. A certificate plus U.S. \$1,000 will be presented to the winner. The award will be offered during each biennial symposium. A special committee will be set up to evaluate papers nominated for the award. 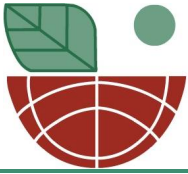


NOMINATION PROCESS AND DEADLINE
